Legislation on funding

LEGISLATIVE ACTS FRAMING CPU FUNDING

- ◆ Law 1901 on association
 - **Non-profit / no taxes** OR profit (within a limit) and taxes
 - Member fees allowed
 - Public and private funding allowed
 - Donations and inheritance allowed
 - Commercial activities allowed (with conditions)
- ◆ Education Code
 - Ministry of higher education is responsible for providing CPU with suitable premises
 - CPU can ask for ministry officers' support
 - CPU can perceive fees from its member/public funds/other resources in respect of its status

CPU BUDGET IS CONTROLLED BY THE GENERAL ACCOUNTING OFFICE

MODALITIES AND CONDITIONS OF FUNDING

- ◆ Administration and organization
 - Article 14 : specifies that acceptance of donation and inheritance must follow civil code regulations
- ◆ Annual resources
 - Article 16/17 : list of the provisions CPU can have (placement, buildings, budget surplus)
 - Article 18 : list of the annual sources of funding
 - Article 19 : specifies obligation of presentation of the annual budget/expenses to the minister of higher education

MODALITIES AND CONDITIONS OF FUNDING

- ◆ Rules and regulation – Section 3
 - Article 15 : membership fees are decided each in plenary session based on a proposal prepared by the bureau and approved by the CP2U
 - Article 16 : Reimbursement rules for activities led by members of CPU

Overview of the funding

AVERAGE REPARTITION OF FUNDING

- ◆ 50 % of the budget comes from the ministry
- ◆ 45 % of the budget comes from the member fees
- ◆ 5% comes from various other sources (donation, commercial activities...)
