SGH is famous for its **tradition, flexible adjustments** of programmes to students' needs, **unquestionable education level**, and **successful alumni**.

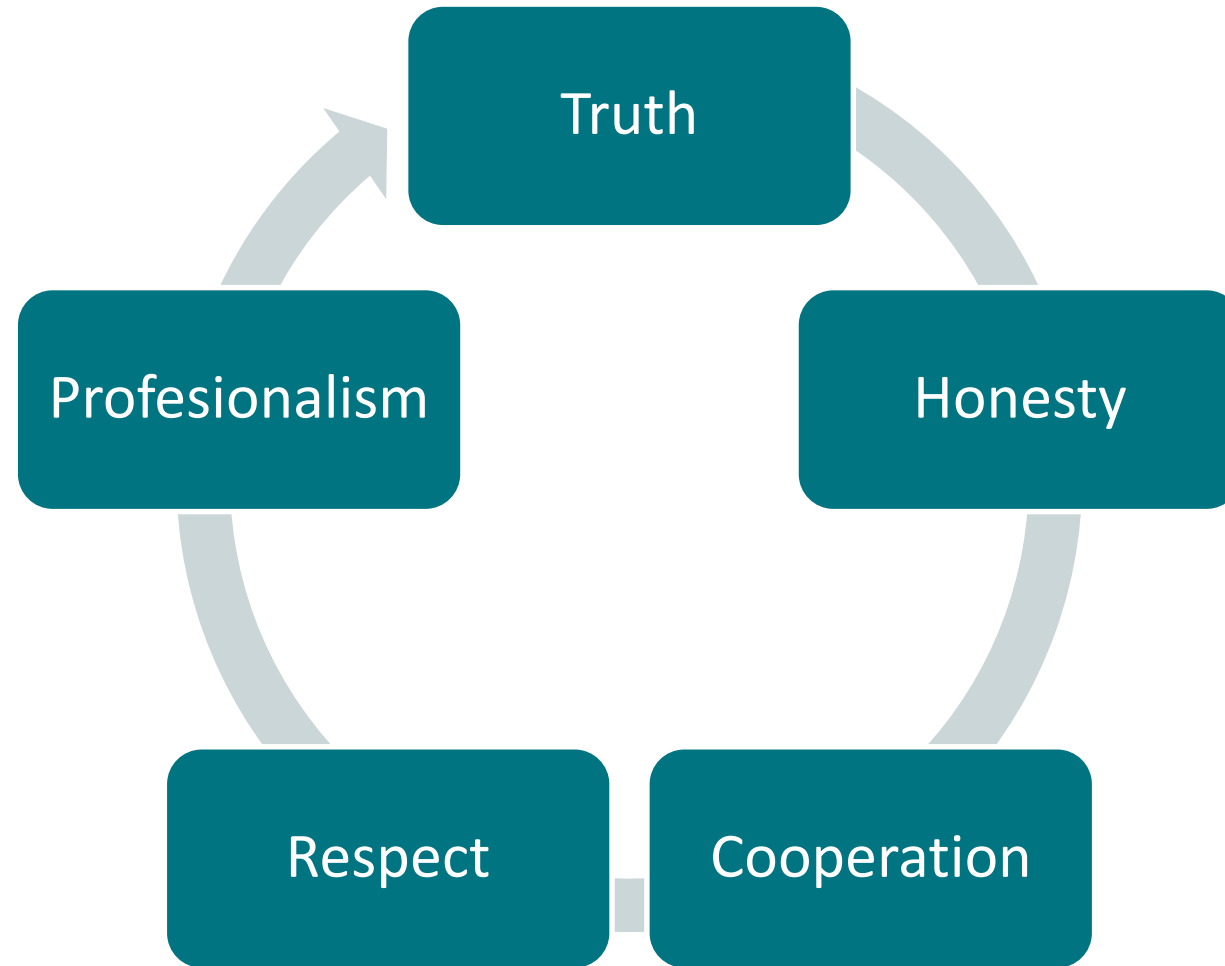
